



# The NPC-SI calculator for individuals older than four years

### How to use the calculator

Carefully assess the signs and symptoms, selecting those that are present in the individual you wish to screen.

Then calculate the total Risk Prediction Score (RPS), before referring the individual on for further testing as appropriate.

What to do next

## Understanding the results

Risk Prediction Score	Referral advice
<40	LOW likelihood of NPC Discount other possible causes
40-70	MODERATE likelihood of NPC  Contact your nearest NPC referral centre to discuss
≥70	HIGH likelihood of NPC Refer the individual to an NPC referral centre for immediate testing
